



November 4, 2008 General Election Important Dates

October 6, 2008

The Alameda County Registrar of Voters will begin mailing out Vote By Mail Ballots for the November 4, 2008 election.

Completed Vote By Mail Ballots may be dropped off at the City Clerk's office, 37101 Newark Boulevard, 5th Floor during regular business hours. The ballot box will be available until 5:00 pm on Election Day. The City Clerk may only accept Vote By Mail Ballots from registered voters within Alameda County.

October 20, 2008

The last day to register to vote for the November 4, 2008 election. Voter registration forms are available in the City Clerk's office. Voter registration forms are also available at the Registrar of Voters Office located at 1225 Fallon Street, Room G-1, Oakland, California, all offices of the Department of Motor Vehicles, public libraries, and post offices. October 28, 2008
