**NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS**

**SPORTSFIELD PARK SYNTHETIC TURF FIELDS and NEWARK SKATE PARK**  
**AT SPORTSFIELD PARK, PROJECT NOS. 1192 and 1193**

The City Council of the City of Newark invites sealed bids for the construction of public improvements for the Sportsfield Park Synthetic Turf Fields and Newark Skate Park at Sportsfield Park, Project Nos. 1192 and 1193, City of Newark, Alameda County, California.

Bids shall be enclosed in a sealed opaque envelope. The envelope shall be sealed and clearly marked on its face with the Bidder's name, address and the notation "SEALED BID ENCLOSED, CITY OF NEWARK" with an identification of the PROJECT NAME, PROJECT NUMBERS and BID DATE as identified on this Notice to Bidders. If the bid is sent by mail, the sealed bid envelope shall be enclosed in a separate mailing envelope/box. The mailing envelope/box shall also be clearly marked on its face with the notation "SEALED BID ENCLOSED, CITY OF NEWARK" with an identification of the PROJECT NAME, PROJECT NUMBERS and BID DATE as identified on this Notice to Bidders.

Sealed bids must be delivered to the office of the City Cashier of the City of Newark at 37101 Newark Boulevard, First Floor Cashier Counter, Newark, California, before **2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 2, 2019**. At that time, all bids will be publicly opened, examined and declared.

The improvements are generally described as follows:

Replacement of natural turf field with infill synthetic turf field and construction of concrete skate park at Sportsfield Park, within the City of Newark.

The scope of work includes removal of approximately six acres of grass turf and irrigation; excavation; rough and fine grading; installation of drainage systems, stormwater treatment measures, chain link fencing and gates, a complete synthetic turf and infill system with sports striping, site furnishings; asphalt concrete and Portland cement concrete walkways; modification of irrigation system; landscaping and irrigation; electrical infrastructure; construction of an approximately 12,000 square-foot skate park; and other related items of work as needed to complete said improvements.

Additive alternate items of work include the installation of 25-foot tall netting, additional landscaping, lighting and electrical work, and other related items of work as needed to complete said improvements.

It is the City's intent to award the contract for this work on April 25, 2019 with a Notice to Proceed issued on April 26, 2019. The first working day will be April 29, 2019.

**The synthetic turf fields shall be substantially complete and ready for public recreational use no later than Friday, August 23, 2019.** Improvements required to be considered "substantially complete" shall include the synthetic turf and infill system, complete in place; all sports field

striping; perimeter fencing and gates; and the synthetic turf subdrain and downstream drainage system.

A mandatory pre-bid meeting at the project site is scheduled for this project on **Tuesday, March 26, 2019** at 3:00 p.m. Prospective Contractors must attend this meeting.

The Contractor shall possess a valid **Class A** California Contractors license at the time of the bid opening. The successful Bidder shall furnish a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond. Items of work in conjunction with this project are included in the proposal.

#### **MANDATORY SHOTCRETE CONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS & QUALIFICATIONS**

In order for a bid to be considered responsive to this invitation for bids, the minimum experience of the contractor performing the shotcrete concrete work shall be the completion of five (5) skate park projects of comparable size, finishes, bowl depth coping type and features built within the past five (5) years. If shotcrete contractor intends to use an ACI certified nozzleman for shotcrete installation other than the nozzleman who performed the work for the required qualifying projects, the contractor must submit four (4) qualifying projects that the ACI certified nozzleman has performed. Documentation of mandatory qualifications shall be made in the section entitled "SHOTCRETE CONTRACTOR INFORMATION" included in the Bid forms.

#### **MANDATORY SYNTHETIC TURF FIELD COMPANY REQUIREMENTS & QUALIFICATIONS:**

In order for a bid to be considered responsive to this invitation for bids, the minimum experience of the company that both manufactures and installs the synthetic turf field shall meet the requirements included in the section entitled "SYNTHETIC TURF FIELD CONTRACTOR INFORMATION" included in the Bid forms.

#### **MANDATORY POST BID-OPENING INFORMATION:**

In order to assist in the bid evaluation, the apparent low bidder will be required to complete and submit the form entitled "SHOTCRETE CONTRACTOR INFORMATION" and provide the information listed on document entitled "SYNTHETIC TURF FIELD COMPANY INFORMATION" included in the Bid Proposal within two (2) working days of notification by City that it is the apparent low bidder. Notice to the bidder may be given orally, by telephone, or by e-mail sent to the address supplied by the bidder. Failure to submit the SHOTCRETE CONTRACTOR INFORMATION form and the information contained on the SYNTHETIC TURF FIELD CONTRACTOR INFORMATION form by 5:00pm on the second day following notification may result in the bid being deemed non-

responsive and therefore rejected, and the City will then determine the next apparent low bidder.


As of July 1, 2014, all Contractors bidding on this project are required to register with the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) and to pay the required annual fee. Under California Labor Code section 1771.1, as amended by SB 854, unless registered with the DIR, a Contractor may not bid or be listed as a Subcontractor for any bid proposal submitted for public works projects on or after March 1, 2015.

The City of Newark reserves the right to reject any or all bids, and to waive any minor informalities, irregularities and/or bid non-responsiveness that does not influence the competitive nature of the bid. This project has multiple "Additive Alternate Bid Items." This work, or any portion thereof, may or may not be included in any contract to be awarded. "Additive Alternate Bid Items" will not be considered in determining the basis of the lowest bid. The City Council will award the project, if it is awarded, to the lowest responsible Bidder as determined by the Total Base Bid only.

The City of Newark hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business and women owned business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, religious creed, color, national origin, ancestry, physical disability, mental disability, medical condition, genetic information, marital status, sex, gender, gender identity, gender expression, age, sexual orientation, including a perception that the person has any of those characteristics or that the person is associated with a person who has, or is perceived to have, any of those characteristics in consideration for an award.

Pursuant to Section of 1773 of the Labor Code, the general prevailing rate of wages in the county in which the work is to be done has been determined by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations of the State of California. These wages are set forth in the General Prevailing Wage Rates for this project. The Contractor and all subcontractors shall pay all their employees performing labor under this Contract salaries or wages at least equal to the general prevailing wage rates for the particular crafts, classifications or types of workers employed on this project. These wage rates appear in the latest Department of Industrial Relations publication. Future effective wage rates which have been predetermined and are on file with the Department of Industrial Relations are referenced but not printed in said publication, and are available on the internet at [www.dir.ca.gov](http://www.dir.ca.gov).
