1. INTRODUCTION

The City of Newark invites sealed bids for the supply of a Land Pride 72" Overseeder and First Products AERA-vator 60" to the City of Newark, Alameda County, California. The bid will be awarded to the responsible bidder representing the lowest total bid rate per unit cost.

2. BACKGROUND

The City of Newark is located in Southern Alameda County at the east end of the Dumbarton Bridge, 30 miles south of Oakland 15 miles north of San Jose. Newark was incorporated as a General Law City in 1955 and has a Council/Manager form of government. Newark's population is approximately 47,460 with an encompassed area of approximately 13 square miles. 3. GENERAL

The City is requesting bids for the purchase of one (1) 72" Overseeder and one (1) First Products AERA-vator 60". Additions to the term of the agreement, as allowed, will be subject to review and approval of the Public Works Director, City Manager, and/or City Council.

4. SCOPE OF SERVICES

The scope of services includes:

- Land Pride 72" Overseeder
- First Products AERA-vator 60"
- Standard One Year Warranty for All Equipment
