### THE POSITION

Under the supervision of the professional staff, serves as a lifeguard, and/or swim instructor for the City's diverse aquatic program. This position will provide appropriate training in lifeguard training and swim lessons to all who qualify for it. This position is classified under Part-Time/Seasonal/Temporary.

### Lifeguard I Qualifications

Must be 15 years of age or older.

Certification in Lifeguard Training, First Aid, and CPR for the Professional Rescuer is required

Some aquatics and water safety experience is desirable.

### Lifeguard II Qualifications (Swim Instructor)

Must be 15 years of age or older

Certification in Lifeguard Training, First Aid, and CPR for the Professional Rescuer is required

Certification in Water Safety Instructor Aide is highly desirable or has experience in teaching swim lessons


### General Qualifications for all Positions

Ability to engage in physical activity.

Ability to swim 300 yards using all basic swimming strokes.
