The Position

Under the supervision of the Aquatic Sr. Supervisor and Aquatics Coordinator, assists in the planning, direction, leadership and staffing for a variety of aquatic programs. Typical programs to include: lap swim, recreation swim, swim lessons, camps, and private rentals. All Applicants must meet the minimum "General Qualifications" as outlined in order to be considered for an interview and skills assessment test.

This position is a competitive based position which must be reapplied for on an annual basis by any current Sr. Lifeguard or new applicant seeking to become a Senior Lifeguard for the Summer Season.

Examples of Duties

- Supervises pool staff and instructs them in proper performance of their duties
- Supervises the swim lesson program
- Conducts staff training sessions
- Enforces safety rules and regulations
- Serves as a swim instructor or lifeguard as needed
- Performs general maintenance and clerical duties
- Maintains accurate records and completes related reports
- Ensures cleanliness and safety of the facility
- Maintains good public relations
- Other related duties as assigned

General Qualifications

Must be 18 years of age or older or completed high school or equivalent

Certification in:

- Lifeguard Training,
- Water Safety Instructor (WSI)*
- First Aid
- CPR for the Professional Rescuer

Certification in Lifeguard Training Instructor, or other instructor certifications is highly desirable

Knowledge of the Sportsman computer system desirable


Must meet all qualification of Lifeguard 1, Lifeguard 2, and Recreation instructor positions*

Must be Available for a variety of shifts and times to meet program needs including weekends.
