The Position

Under the supervision of the professional staff, serves as a certified swim instructor for the City's diverse aquatic program. This position will provide appropriate instruction for those in the program. This position is classified under Part-time/Seasonal/Temporary.

- Enforces pool rules and regulations
- Rescues swimmers in distress and administers First Aid as needed
- Instructs a variety of swim classes for all ages and ability levels
- Develops lesson plans for swim lessons
- Maintains accurate records
- Maintains pool and bathroom areas in a safe and clean condition
- Maintains good public relations
- Other related duties as assigned

WSI Instructor Qualifications

Must be 17 years of age or older.

One or more years of experience as a Lifeguard I/II

Certification in Lifeguard Training, First Aid, & CPR for the Professional Rescuer through our program.

Certification in American Red Cross Water Safety Instruction or equivalent

Good writing and communication skills

General Qualifications for all Positions

Ability to engage in physical activity.


Ability to deal with stressful situations.
