PRESCHOOL & KINDERTOTS

Preparing children for success in Kindergarten!

REGISTRATION: Register in person at the Silliman Aquatics Center, Clark W. Redeker Newark Senior Center or by fax at 510-578-4851. Payments are accepted in full or in 2 payments for an additional \$10 at time of registration. The second payment is due prior to October 27, 12:00pm with a \$10 late fee if not paid in full. Children may be registered for only one Preschool or Kindertots class. Immunization records are not required.

PROGRAM EXPECTATIONS: It is expected that children enrolling in Preschool or Kindertots are ready to separate from parents and be able to fully participate in class. Children must be fully potty trained (no pull-up).

HELPER DAY: For each child enrolled, parents are required to actively assist the instructor and provide a snack and/or beverage four times for Kindertots B, three times for the Kindertots A and two times for Preschool A during the session. Parents will be billed a \$45 fee per enrolled child for missed days. Providing snack/beverage is required for those parents paying the \$45 helper day fee.
