The City of Newark Recreation & Community Services Department Age Policy states that we do not promote children to the next grade level until the official school year begins. Therefore, the Teen Area will not admit incoming 6th graders until the first day of school as a 6th grader. Once school begins in the fall, new 6th graders will be admitted to the Teen Area and recently graduated 12th graders will then be considered adults who will lose their Teen Area privileges. All guests must be
10 years of age or older.

Features include exclusive use of the Teen Area, use of all Teen Area equipment (2 pool tables, ping pong table foosball, air hockey table, lounge area with PS3 & Wii), and a staff person to monitor the area. Minimum 1 chaperone (at least 21 years old) is required per 15 teens. Rates: \$50R/\$60NR per hour for up to 20 teens, \$80R/\$90NR per hour for 21-50 teens; Must also pay a \$300 refundable deposit at the time of booking.

AMERICAN RED CROSS BABYSITTER'S TRAINING CERTIFICATION

Through hands on training and classroom discussion, this course provides the knowledge and skills necessary to safely and responsibly care for infants and children up to the age of 10, as well as to manage a babysitting business! Upon successful completion of the course, participants will earn the American Red Cross Babysitter's Training Certification, along with the American Red Cross Pediatric CPR & First Aid Certification. Participants must be at least 11 years of age by the first day of class.

Certification Requirements: To receive an American Red Cross certification, participants must: 1. Attend all class sessions in their entirety, 2. Demonstrate competency in all required skills and activities, 3. Demonstrate competency in the final skills scenarios, 4. Correctly answer 80% of the questions on the final written exam, 5. Please note that some tests can only be taken once. Failure to meet the course prerequisites requirements will result in forfeiture of class fees and certification will not be granted. CPR/AED CERTIFICATION: BLENDED LEARNING COURSES

This course is designed to teach individuals how to respond and care for breathing and cardiac emergencies. Learners must complete the online course before participating in the skill session. The online portion of blended learning features simulation learning. Simulation learning provides an engaging online experience where learners respond to real-world emergencies by going on "missions". These missions take place in a variety of settings – from the office cubicle to the factory floor to the school cafeteria. Once your training has been successfully completed, you'll receive a two-year certification in CPR/AED, and have the ability to access refresher materials at any time during your certification period.
