**All guests must be 10 years of age or older. 2 options to choose from!**

With Swimming: Totally Teen Package includes exclusive use of the Teen Area for 2 hours plus additional 15 minutes for both set-up & clean-up and entrance to the Open Recreation Swim. Because the Teen Area doesn't have direct access to the pool deck all swimming is done prior to or after your room use time. Base Booking fee is \$465R/ \$495NR for up to 15 guests. Additional guests charged \$11R/ \$13NR per person. Fee includes a refundable \$300 deposit. All guests (adults and teens, swimming or not) in attendance will be included in the final count of your party package. Each party receives 3 free guests. Room Use Only: Features include exclusive use of the Teen Area, use of all Teen Area equipment (2 pool tables, ping pong table foosball, air hockey table, lounge area with PS3 & Wii), and a staff person to monitor the area. Minimum 1 chaperone (at least 21 years old) is required per 15 teens. Rates: \$50R/\$60NR per hour for up to 20 teens, \$80R/\$90NR per hour for 21-50 teens; Must also pay a \$300 refundable deposit at the time of booking. New! American Red Cross Babysitter's Training Certification  
Ages 11-15

Through hands on training and classroom discussion, this course provides the knowledge and skills necessary to safely and responsibly care for infants and children up to the age of 10, as well as to manage a babysitting business!

Upon successful completion of the course, participants will earn the American Red Cross Babysitter's Training Certification, along with the American Red Cross Pediatric CPR & First Aid Certification. Participants must be at least 11 years of age by the first day of class.

Certification Requirements: To receive an American Red Cross certification, participants must: 1. Attend all class sessions in their entirety, 2. Demonstrate competency in all required skills and activities, 3. Demonstrate competency in the final skills scenarios, 4. Correctly answer 80% of the questions on the final written exam, 5. Please note that some tests can only be taken once. Failure to meet the course prerequisites requirements will result in forfeiture of class fees and certification will not be granted.
