For grade level specifications, we do not promote children to the next grade level until the official school year begins.

A Word About Department Wait-lists

Newark Recreation and Community Services Department provides customers wait-list opportunities in the event that your class of choice is full. Should an opening occur, you will receive a phone call, at which time you will have 24 hours to respond. Should we not hear from you within the 24 hours, you will forfeit that space and we will move to the next wait-list customer. Placement on the wait-list does not guarantee registration in the next session.

Late Pick-Up Fee

We reserve the right to assess a late fee on any of our programs that have a specific ending time. The fee of \$1 per minute (\$5 minimum) will be charged for those participants not picked up by the scheduled ending time.

Missed Classes/Make-Up Policy

We do not offer credits, refunds, or make-up classes when you miss a program day. Unfortunately, we do not have the ability to do this with the amount of programs that we offer. Additionally, we would have to increase the fees for all of our programs if we were to do this and we want to make sure we keep our prices affordable to the community.
