



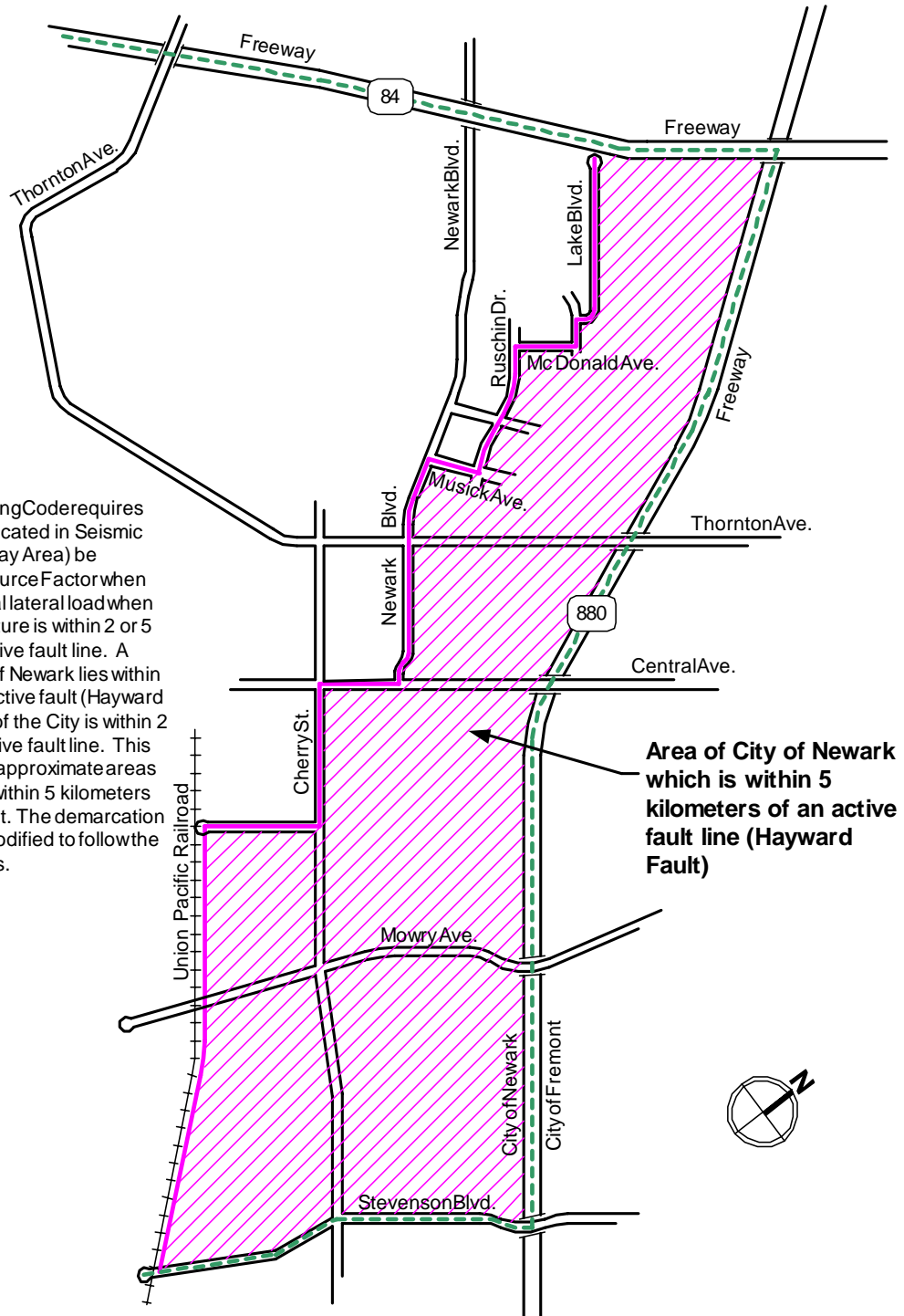
Near-Source Factor – Distance to Fault Line

CITY OF NEWARK, CALIFORNIA

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The California Building Code requires that all structures located in Seismic Zone 4 (the entire Bay Area) be assigned a Near-Source Factor when determining the total lateral load when the proposed structure is within 2 or 5 kilometers of an active fault line. A portion of the City of Newark lies within 5 kilometers of an active fault (Hayward Fault). No portion of the City is within 2 kilometers of an active fault line. This map delineates the approximate areas in the City located within 5 kilometers of the Hayward Fault. The demarcation has been slightly modified to follow the center line of streets.
