Section 1013.8 of the 2013 California Building Code requires in one- and two-family and multiple-family dwellings, where the opening of the sill portion of an operable window is located more than 72 inches above the finish grade or other surface below, the lowest part of the clear opening of the window shall be a minimum 36 inches above the finished floor surface of the room in which the window is located. Glazing between the floor and a height of 36 inches shall be fixed or have openings such that a 4-inch diameter sphere can not pass.
